Please remember to observe the following:

- 1- 10 MPH throughout the park – bikes, and cars. All are to stop at the stop signs.
- 2- Please observe the handicapped and other designated parking – especially by the Post Office
- 3- Do not park on empty lots – come to the office for a permit to place in your window
- 4- Illegal parking will be ticketed and charged \$5 per day.
- 5- For loading and unloading, please come to the office for a permit.

Please let us know when you arrive. We want to say hello and find out how your summer was. It is also important for when someone comes in and asks if you are back yet.

If you observe a problem (water leak, lights out, etc.) come to the office and we will make out a work order for the Maintenance Department. This will enable them to fix the problem in a timely fashion.
