Euchre will start on Tuesday, October 23 at 7:00 PM in the Card Room. Beginners are welcome, come down and learn. We look forward to seeing you.

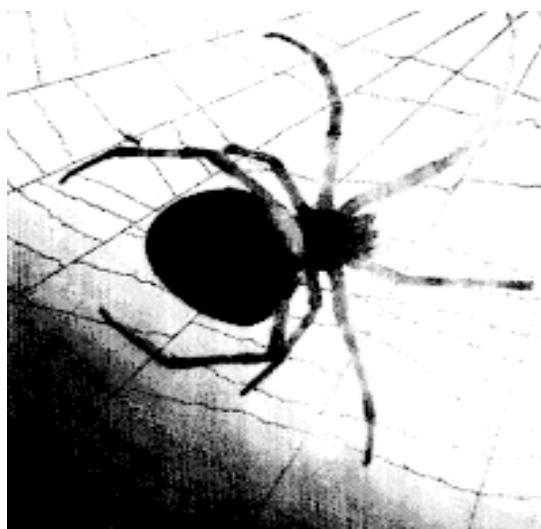
Texas Hold-em Poker
