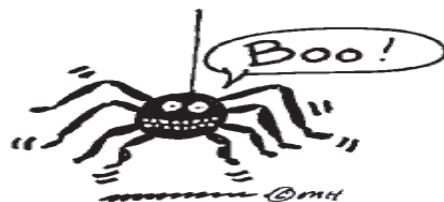

In the event that the Activity Office does not receive a phone call from you by 10:00am, we will call you to see if you forgot to call us. If we do not receive an answer, two office personnel will come to your home to check on you.

Each person should agree to leave a key in the main office for emergencies purposes. The key is optional but could be very important in the case of an emergency.

If you wish to be part of this group please be sure to fill out a reference card and leave it with the activities office along with your key.
