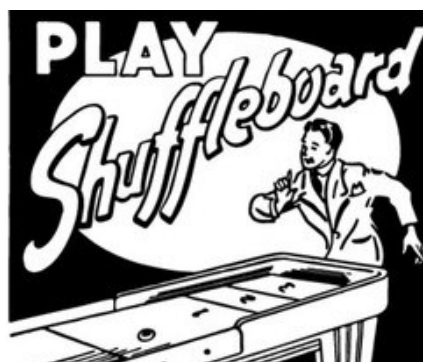

Safety Rules and Precautions

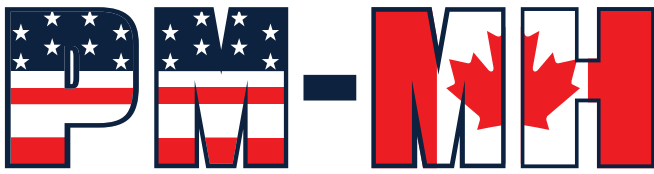
Below is a list of most commonly noted concerns:
