Please First of all, I want to welcome everyone back for the season! For those of you who are first timers I want to welcome you to the Rincon Country family! I hope all of you had a terrific summer!

Our summer here at RCW was a busy one indeed for our maintenance crew, along with our legion of faithful subcontractors.

One of the many projects we did over the summer was resurfacing the east end of B Street from V Street to the southeast corner of the Resort and halfway up the Deluxe Pull Through lots. A brandnew concrete gutter was added to preserve the streets for many years to come. This project will be continuing next summer with the completion of the other half of this section of B Street.

Another project that you might have noticed is the colorful new front entrance and exit gates, as well as a fresh coat of paint on the stucco. We're also excited to announce that we have a brand-new "Scan to Enter" barcode reader that will negate the need for cards on the right-hand resident gate. You can purchase a barcode sticker from the front office that is placed on your vehicle's windshield to automatically open the gate when you pass by the scanner. These stickers are \$15.00 each. Ask the front office for details. If you choose not to purchase a sticker, cards will still continue to work on the left-hand entrance gate.

The spa at the main pool has received a much-needed renovation. We removed the outdated wood paneling and added a modern coating of smooth stucco. We also added a fresh coat of paint to brighten up the area. We're sure you are going to enjoy the tranquil ambiance of this newly rejuvenated space!

The main pool bathrooms and showers have been remodeled complete with new tiles, partitions, fixtures, and an exhaust system to help with humidity. Take a peek. They look great!

The railroad has a new pergola! This will give the guys and gals some much-needed shade while they are sitting out there running the trains. Stop by and check it out!

A new pet washing station has been installed on the northwest corner of the East Laundry Building. This new amenity is available for all residents, free of charge. We all know that cleaning a pet can be quite a chore, especially in a park model or RV, so come try it out. We're sure your furry friends will enjoy it!




