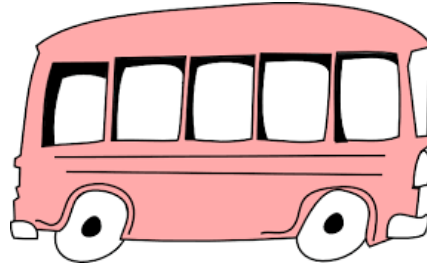

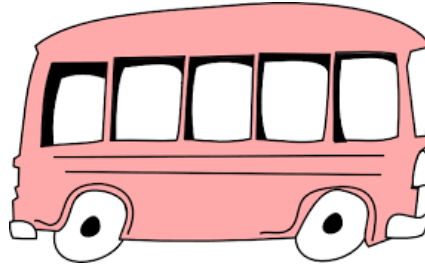
You will also get to experience the Desert Museum's gardens and its vibrant ecosystem.

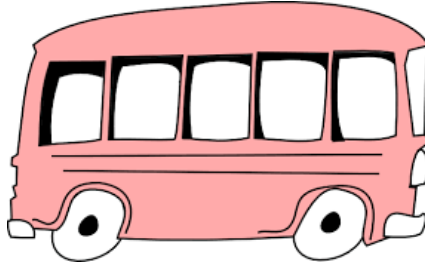
A festival tradition in the village of Tubac since 1959, the Tubac Festival of the Arts is Southern Arizona’s longest running art festival.

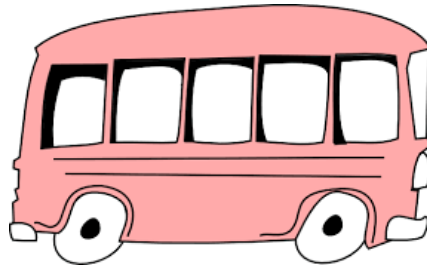
On this shuttle you will visit Barrio Brewing Company, Moto Sonora Brewing Company and Copper Mine Brewing Company.
