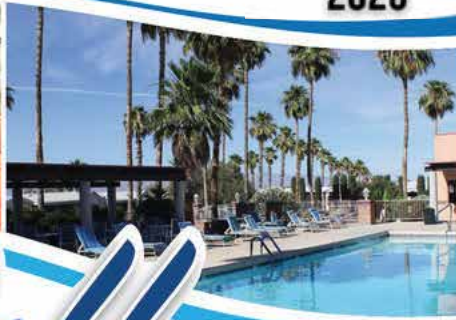

# Safety First!

## *I'm OK*

Here at RCW we want to make sure you are A-OK! The "I'm Okay Club" is a program for guests and residents who are living alone.

Once you sign up with the Activity Office, you must call in daily before 10:00AM. This is just a daily check-in by phone that allows us to make sure you are OK. If you don't call in by 10:00AM, we will try and reach you. If we are unsuccessful, we will come to your house and check on you.

Please stop by the Activity Office during the season or the Main Office during the summer to sign up. We look forward to hearing from you.

Concerned about a neighbor? Call the Activity Office and we will reach out.

## *Safety and Wildlife*



For maximum safety, carry a flashlight when you are walking at night, keep pets on a leash, and remain alert to an unlikely, but possible encounter.

## *Avoid Heat Related Illness*

Drink water - at least 2 liters (8 cups) of water per day.

Dress properly - lightweight, light colored clothing, wear a hat or carry an umbrella. Apply sunscreen to exposed skin.

Take it easy - avoid strenuous activity. If you must, do it in the morning between 4:00AM to 7:00AM (summer time). Take breaks in a cool place if possible.

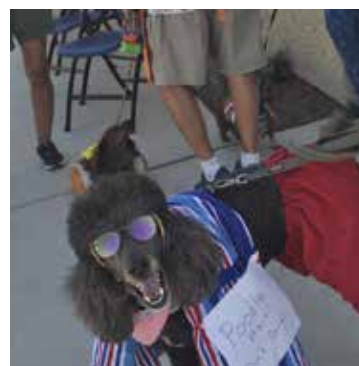

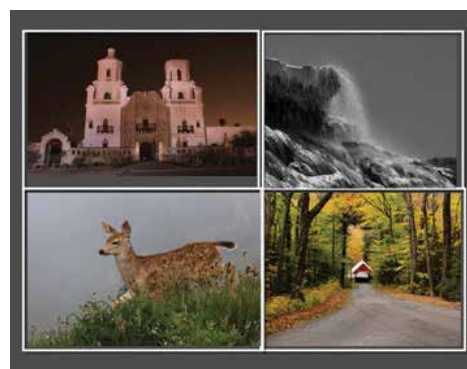

# ReCap

Tucson Fire Department

Recap from the Tucson Fire Department presentation from the Friday Morning Coffee & Donut Program.

- > Know the area hospitals. The closest are St. Mary's Hospital, Banner Main and Banner South. It would be helpful if residents check to see what hospitals will accept your insurance.
- > Using the Urgent Cares on Irvington and Ajo for non-emergency care, it would help reduce the wait times at the emergency rooms.
- > Having medical information on the refrigerator to include Name, date of birth, Important medical history, medications and allergies.
- > The two closest Fire Stations to your facility are Fire Station 15 located at 2002 S Mission, and Fire Station 18 located at 1855 W Drexel. We do free blood pressure checks at the stations during business hours. If there is an emergency please don't drive to the station, just call 911 because we might not be home.
- > The City of Tucson Fire Department does not charge for responses to your emergency, call if you need us. We also respond for lift assist.
- > Please call early if you think you have any type of stroke symptoms such as a severe headache without a history of them, confusion, one-sided weakness, slurred speech etc. There is a narrow window of time to treat these symptoms.
- > If you fall and you're on blood thinners, please pay particular attention to these stroke symptoms.
- > Desert safety - Please watch the weather and expect the hot days to get hot fast don't let the cold morning fool you. If you're pricked from one of our thorny plants, please watch for signs of infection and seek medical attention. These infections can get out of hand quickly.



## *Early Bird Ticket Sales*

We are hearing the NEW process for purchasing tickets for the upcoming month events is working well.

Thank you for your patience while we work through the kinks to make this process more streamline.

### **New - Secure Drop Box in Coffee Room.**

When the **Activity Office is Closed** (evenings and weekends), place your completed ticket & reservation form with payment into

numbered envelope. Put envelope into this Drop Box no later than NOON Monday. DO NOT hand to the Mail Room or the Main Office.

When the **Activity Office is Open** stop in to say Hi, and hand in your completed ticket & reservation form with payment to the Activity Staff no later than NOON Monday. Your order request will be processed later in the day and your receipt and tickets will be put into your mail box by Wednesday.

We anticipate the past 'Ticket Tuesday' process will shift to this new process, eliminating the standing in line on Ticket Tuesday's in inclement weather.

The words 'Ticket Tuesday' can be a tad confusing. So put your thinking caps on...we're going to need a new name to replace the wording 'Ticket Tuesday'... **NEXT Early Bird 'Ticket Tuesday' is Dec. 19th for JANUARY events. The January Ticket Reservation form will be in your mail box by Dec. 14th.**

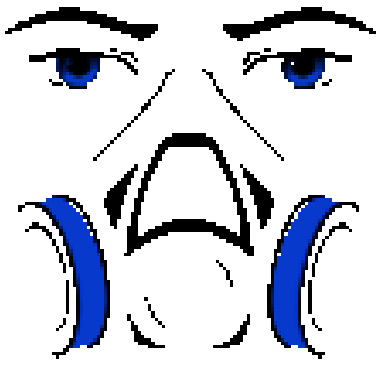

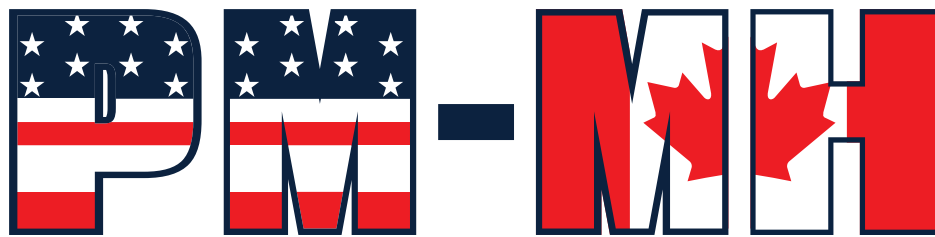
