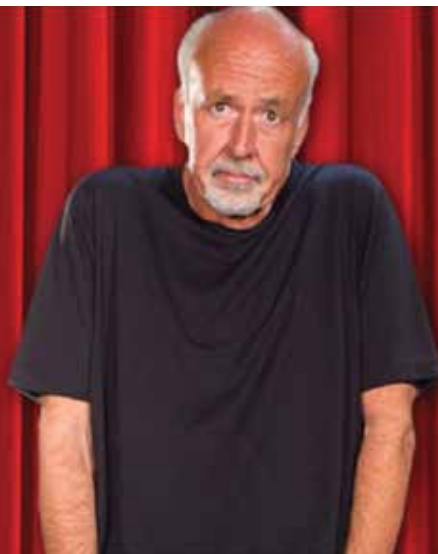

## Phase 10 Card Game



Rummy like in a sense that runs and pairs are required. There are 10 phases that each player needs to complete to win the game.
