



"What to Look for in Medical Evacuation Services" Be an informed traveler. The following describes some of the "fine-print" offers you want to investigate when comparing medical transport services.

Hospital-to-hospital transport. Other plans = requires approval by their Medical Director. SkyMed = transports you home at your choice.

Ground or air transport for medically necessary services. Other plans = requires preapproval prior to transport. SkyMed = no approval for ground and none for initial helicopter transport.

Mileage restrictions. Other plans = over 100 to 150 miles away from home. SkyMed = provides coverage from your doorstep.

Visitor transport upon your hospital admission. Other plans = requires 3-to-7-day delay. SkyMed = on first day.
