Available to all residents December in the Activity Office. This guide will have details about all current clubs and contact information. If there are changes please notify the Activities Office.



Each refund will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis. A minimum of six (6) reserved seats per trip are needed. Charter bus trip cancellations require a three (3) week notice for refund.
