

Shuttle & Charter Refund Policy

Always keep your receipts from the Activity Office. Refunds can only be given with a receipt. Shuttle trips - No refunds or cancellations within seven (7) days of shuttle departure. Each refund will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis. A minimum of six (6) reserved seats per trip are needed. Charter bus trip cancellations require a three (3) week notice for refund.




