- > Drink Water: Aim for at leas 2 liters (8 cups) per day.
- > Dress Appropriately: Wear lightweight, light-colored clothing, a hat, or carry an umbrella. Don't forget sunscreen on exposed skin.



- > Take It Easy: Avoid strenuous activity. If necessary, do it in the early morning (4:00–7:00 AM during summer).
- > Take Breaks: Rest in a cool place whenever possible.

How does the Propane Tank Exchange Program work?

When you join the program, you will be provided with a tank or tanks based on your needs. The only cost of the program, other than propane costs, is a one-time membership fee, for an Introductory Price of \$60 for a 60lb tank or \$100 for each 100lb tank. That's it! No lease, and no other fees. We will deliver and hook up a full tank(s) to your home. Then, whenever you are low on propane, just call the office and we will deliver and hook up another full tank to your home on our next scheduled delivery day. We will then take the tank that you depleted, fill it up and bill you for the amount you used. It's that simple!

(This Introductory Price will expire December 31, 2025).

Questions and Answers

Question: How long am I committed to the Program for?

Answer: You can cancel the program anytime you choose.

Question: What if I sell my park model? Is my membership transferable?

Answer: The membership in the Propane Tank Exchange Program is not transferrable. The new owner will

have to enroll in the Program if they wish to participate.

Question: What are the delivery days and operational hours for tank exchanges?

Answer: You will need to call by 4:00pm the day before you want delivery. Deliveries will be made Monday

- Friday. If you need emergency delivery (after 4:00pm M-F or on the weekend) there will be a

\$75.00 emergency charge to deliver.

Question: Will my propane cost fluctuate?

Answer: Like gasoline, the price of propane does fluctuate based on seasonality and availability. Our

charges will be in direct correlation with these factors at the time we purchase the propane from

our supplier.

Question: How many gallons of propane are in a 100lb tank and a 60lb tank?

Answer: There are 23.6 gallons in a 100lb tank and 14.2 gallons in a 60lb tank.

Question: Will there be a minimum amount of refill gallons required for propane exchange delivery?

Answer: The minimum refill gallons required for delivery will be one half of the tank capacity to be

exchanged (i.e. 60lb is minimum 7 gallons and 100lb is minimum 12 gallons).

Question: Can my BBQ tank be part of the exchange program?

Answer: No, we only offer exchange on 60lb and 100lb tanks. You may bring your BBQ tank to the refill

station on scheduled walk-up days.

Question: I own my own propane tank(s). What are my options?

Answer: You can still enroll in the Program. After the Park inspection deems your certified tank(s) suitable

for the Program, the Park will take ownership of your tank(s) in lieu of the enrollment fee.

Question: What are my options if I currently rent a large 100-gallon tank?

Answer: You can contact your current propane company to remove their tank. We will assist in arranging

for a pigtail and regulator that will need to be installed at an additional cost. We will then install a

tank(s) suitable for your needs.






