

Call in daily before 10:00 AM to check in.


If you don't call we will try to reach you. If unsuccessful a team member will visit to ensure you're safe.


Wildlife



For maximum safety, carry a **flashlight** and turn it on when you are walking at night. Keep pets on a leash. Remain alert to an unlikely, but possible encounter.

Stay Safe in the Heat!

- > Drink Water: Aim for at least 2 liters (8 cups) per day.
- > Dress Appropriately: Wear lightweight, light-colored clothing, a hat, or carry an umbrella. Don't forget sunscreen on exposed skin.
- > Take It Easy: Avoid strenuous activity. If necessary, do it in the early morning (4:00–7:00 AM during summer).
- > Take Breaks: Rest in a cool place whenever possible.



Stay hydrated, stay cool, and enjoy the sunshine safely!

AED Devices



We have four (4) Automated External Defibrillator (AED) devices. Make it a point to learn their locations. There is one in the Breezeway near the Auditorium, D street Laundry, Rally Room, and Pickleball/Tennis courts.
