



Alfa Motorhome will be hosting a doughnut and coffee breakfast and presentation followed by lunch in the Rally Room at 10 am on April 2nd.






January 8 Broadway, Baby!




February 5 Disco Fever

So grab your friends, channel your inner disco diva (or disco king), and get ready for a night of groovy tunes, sparkling style, and feel-good fun!






For maximum safety, carry a **flashlight** and turn it on when you are walking at night.

- > **Drink Water:** Aim for at least 2 liters (8 cups) per day.
- > **Dress Appropriately:** Wear lightweight, light-colored clothing, a hat, or carry an umbrella. Don't forget sunscreen on exposed skin.
- > **Take It Easy:** Avoid strenuous activity. If necessary, do it in the early morning (4:00–7:00 AM during summer).
- > **Take Breaks:** Rest in a cool place whenever possible.

Every **Thursday** at RCW means one thing... 'Earthmade Farmers Market' is in the Breezeway!


